## DOG DESEXING AND MICROCHIPPING

Dog Registration renewal notices will be sent out during the second week of July, with all dogs required to be re-registered by 31 August 2017.

All dogs from the age of 3 months must be registered!

When re-registering, any changes to the registration category must be accompanied by the relevant documents ie desexing, microchipping papers, completed working dog statement. Any pension or seniors concession cards **must be sighted** to receive the discounted rate.

To assist dog owners Council has organised with Red Gum Veterinary Service to hold microchipping days on the 12 July 2017 and the 28 July 2017 for anyone within our Council area to utilise for their Dog and Cats. Red Gum Veterinary Surgery have also offered to give this service and a desexing service at a discount. Details will be included with all renewal letters or further information can be obtain from Council.

If you are planning on having your Dog(s) microchipped and or desexed please do so before you renew your registration so that you can receive the relevant discounts for registration.

There have been sightings of Dingos in the area. If you do see a Dingo please report it to the Orroroo office of DEWNR on 8658 1086.

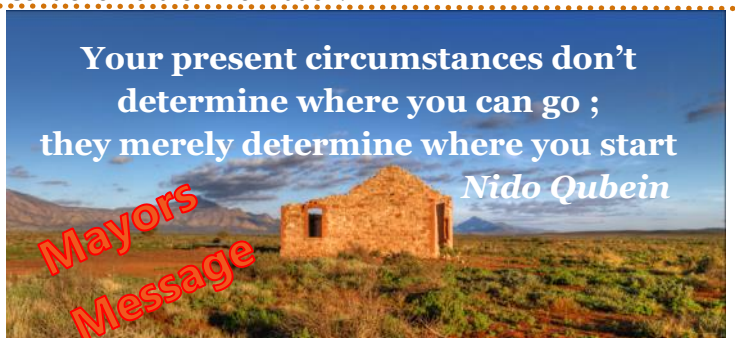
## REFUSE WASTE VOUCHERS
